Dear Residents of RiverWoods Durham, RiverWoods Exeter, and Birch Hill,

After our meeting with the State today things are clear as mud. Here is what we know, we will absolutely be able to provide a vaccine clinic at your community. This will be administered through the Regional Public Health Network. For the onsite clinic, we will handle or help you through any paperwork that is required, at no cost to you. Currently the state receives 17,000 doses per week and those doses are allocated equitably through the State's fixed sites and mobile clinics. There are 300,000 people in this vaccination phase-1B. We expect that our mobile clinics (first dose) would be delivered sometime between now and the first week of March. We do not have any firmer information than that.

The State fixed site is still an option for you. The State portal will open tomorrow (Friday, January 22 at 8:00 a.m.) for all NH residents age 65+ to register for a vaccine date at one of the State's fixed sites. Here is the link: www.vaccines.nh.gov. We do not know what information will be required to register. If you choose this option, please let the Wellness Clinic know the date of your appointment.

We continue to work with the State to determine the best pathway for you to receive your vaccination but information changes on a daily basis. We will continue to update you as we receive more information, but we have better confidence that a clinic **will** happen here, so if you can hang in there with us, it's coming.
