Hi Folks –

Want some good news? After a month of negotiating with the State and CVS we have confirmation that our on-site vaccination clinics for Independent Living residents will be provided by CVS. We don't have exact dates yet but should have them by Monday, February 1. It is our expectation that the first clinics will be performed by mid-February.

If you have an appointment at a State offsite clinic, we suggest keeping that appointment if it's within the next two weeks. Wherever you receive your first dose is where you must receive your second dose, you cannot get one dose elsewhere and your second dose here.

You should know that this past month has been a collaboration between CVS, the NH CCRCs, our Industry Association, and the Chief of Immunizations from the State. It has not been fun, or perfect (or quick), but it has gotten us to the answer we wanted. The work was worth it. Some of you have friends at other CCRCs in New Hampshire, and they received their dates this week. Don't fret. Our dates are coming. We just happen to be a bit more complex than the others; our RWE campus alone has two times as many residents as the other communities. This virus is teaching us all a lot about patience. Please use yours today... CVS is on it. We are in daily (if not hourly) communication, and we will get you our dates the moment we receive them.

This is great news. We are all so pleased to be able to do this for you. "Better" is coming. Until then, live super small and stay healthy my friends!
